

LRC Arena Guidelines - Public Skating

Please use proper rink etiquette at all times and show other participants courtesy and respect.

Rink etiquette is as follows:

- All guests 7 years of age and under must be **actively supervised** by a responsible person 14 years of age or older.
- All skaters **12 years of age or under MUST wear CSA approved helmets** while on the ice. It is strongly recommended that all skaters wear CSA approved helmets.
- Carrying a baby or child while on the ice is strictly prohibited.
- Skates ONLY! Boots and shoes are not permitted on the ice.
- To avoid collisions, skaters should travel in the same direction around the ice.
- Slower skaters should stay towards the centre of the ice. Faster skaters are to travel around slower skaters on the right hand side (against the boards).
- Backwards skating and excessive speeding is not permitted.
- No figure skating routines are permitted during public skating opportunities.
- Do not block skaters by loitering along the boards or near the gates.
- Do not fool around on the ice and refrain from wrestling and rough play.
- No sticks, rings or pucks are allowed on the ice during public skating opportunities.
- No food or beverages are permitted on the ice or in the arena area.
- Please respect arena equipment, furnishings and structural components at all times. Do not sit on the boards or access the boxes.
- No spitting.
- Personal music players and headphones are not permitted on the ice.
- Skate aides must be approved by arena staff prior to use on an LRC ice surface. Skate aides must not have any sharp edges or points. Walking sticks, wagons, toboggans, sleds, snow racers, child seats, strollers, chairs or ride-ons are not permitted on the ice.
- Our arenas are wheelchair accessible. Wheelchairs may access the ice provided they are clean and free of debris. The User must be capable of controlling their chair on the ice.
