

Arena Conditions of Use

Shinny Hockey Leisure Opportunities

Please use proper rink etiquette at all times and show other participants courtesy and respect.

- **LRC Wristbands MUST be worn at all times while on the ice.**
- **ALL shinny players are required to wear FULL hockey equipment.**
- **Skates ONLY!** Boots and shoes are not permitted on the ice.
- No spitting.
- No body-checking or fighting permitted.
- No slap shots allowed.
- No food or beverages are permitted on the ice or in the arena area.
- **A maximum of 28 players** are allowed on the ice per shinny hockey session.
- Shinny opportunities are offered for various age groups. Participants must follow any advertised age guidelines.
- Hockey nets must be properly set into place with their pins.
- Gates must be kept closed when not in use.
- Please keep the ice free of debris. Remove any broken sticks or blades from the ice.
- All play must come to a complete stop when the whistle is sounded.
- Please respect arena equipment, furnishings and structural components at all times. Do not sit on boards.
- Please refrain from damaging the ice. Chips/holes in the ice must be packed-in immediately as they pose a risk to other players.
- Sunflower seeds, chewing tobacco and glass bottles are not permitted in the arenas, nor anywhere else in the facility.

Equipment Requirements

ADULT SHINNY (18+) Full Hockey Equipment:

*CSA approved hockey helmet with face mask (full or half mask), hockey pants, support cup, hockey gloves, shin/elbow/shoulder pads and a regulation ice hockey stick .

YOUTH SHINNY (17 years of age and under) Full Hockey Equipment:

*CSA approved hockey helmet with **full face mask, neck guard**, hockey pants, support cup, hockey gloves, shin/elbow/shoulder pads and a regulation ice hockey stick .
